Civic Association Dues

The Deerhurst Civic Association sets the dues and snow fund each year based on current and anticipated expenses compared to fund balances. The dues for this year have been set at \$20.00 for the general fund and \$25.00 for the snow removal fund. The money in the Association's general fund is used for many purposes such as community activities, maintenance of Ward Park, liability insurance, etc. The Snow Removal Fund is used for the hiring of a snow removal contractor. Only interior households are assessed the snow removal fee; exterior households (homes on Foulk Road, Murphy Road and Concord Pike) are exempt from the snow fund fee as those roads are plowed by DelDOT).

You will be receiving a request for dues payment from your District Representative in the near future. Due may be paid by check, payable to the Deerhurst Civic Association, or in cash, and delivered to your District Rep or the Association President, John Bird. Your cooperation in paying your dues promptly is greatly appreciated.
